## Minute of the Richland County Board of Adjustments Meeting Thursday, May 4, 2017

Item #1 <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> The Board of Adjustments meeting was called to order by Chairman Randy Heims @ 1:03 pm. The present or who signed up to speak were Randy Heims, Tom McGlynn, Allen Rippchen, Ted Greenheck, Darrell Ripley, Mike Bindl, with Cheryl Dull taking minutes.

Item #2 <u>APPROVE AGENDA AND PUBLICATION</u> Mike stated the meeting had been published in the paper 2 weeks and on the bulletin board downstairs. Moved by Allen to approve the agenda and publication, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom. Motion carried.

Item #3 <u>APPROVE THE MINUTES OF APRIL 2017 MEETING</u> Hearing no changes in the minutes Allen moved to approve as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom. Motion carried.

Item #4 <u>WEIER PETITION</u> Ted Greenheck in present to represent the petition. He stated the Weier's want to build a garage larger than 70 % of the floor space of the primary residence. If he can't buy land it will be considerably smaller in size. He received approval from the Township. Mike stated we have not received anything in writing from the Township and we have not received any comments from the neighbors. Moved by Allen to approve the variance, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom. Motion carried. Mike reminded him to get his Land Use Permit prior to construction.
