Minutes of the Richland County Board of Adjustments Meeting Thursday, April 25th, 2024

Item #1 <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> The Board of Adjustments meeting was called to order by Randy Heims @ 1:00 pm. The present or who signed up to speak were; Committee/Staff: Randy Heims, Allen Rippchen, Tom McGlynn, Matthew Albright.

Public: Devon Rupnow, Brian Campbell

Motion was made by Rippchen to amend the agenda to add approval of minutes from the previous meeting, 2nd by McGlynn.

Item #2 <u>APPROVE AGENDA AND PUBLICATION</u> Matthew stated the meeting had been published in the paper 2 weeks and on the bulletin board downstairs. Moved by _Heims_ to approve the agenda and publication, 2nd by _Rippchen__. Motion carried.

Item #3 <u>BRIAN CAMPBELL PETITION REQUESTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP)</u> <u>TO USE 19102 US HWY 14, IN THE TOWN OF DAYTON AS A SHORT TERM RENTAL</u> <u>PROPERTY</u>. Brian stated that the house sits on a 40 acre parcel with no neighbors within 800' of the house. Albright stated that a DATCP tourist rooming house permit would still be required. Moved by_ McGlynn_ to approve the CUP 2nd by Hiems. Motion carried

Item #4 <u>TO HEAR THE PETITION OF JACOB AND DEVON RUPNOW TO REQUEST A</u> <u>VARIANCE TO THE RESIDENTIAL 1 REAR YARD SETBACK IN SECTION 28, TOWN OF</u> <u>WILLOW</u> Rupnow explained that the agricultural field that joins to the rear of the property is owned by family, who do not have any issues with the setback. Albright stated that letters were sent out to adjacent landowners, and there was no opposition to the variance. Moved by _Rippchen__ to approve the variance, 2nd by _McGlynn_. Motion carried.

Item #5 <u>TO HEAR THE PETITION OF ROYCE DIETER TO REQUEST A VARIANCE TO HAVE 2</u> <u>PERMANENT RESIDENCES ON AN AG/RESIDENTIAL LOT, IN SECTION 18 IN THE TOWN OF</u> <u>DAYTON.</u> No one was present to state their case for the Dieter petition. Heims stated it has be the boards' policy to not grant any variance where the petitioner is not represented. Petitition was tabled until the June 6th meeting.
